



Sweet Getaways: Romantic Hotels Pamper Couples During Seattle Stays



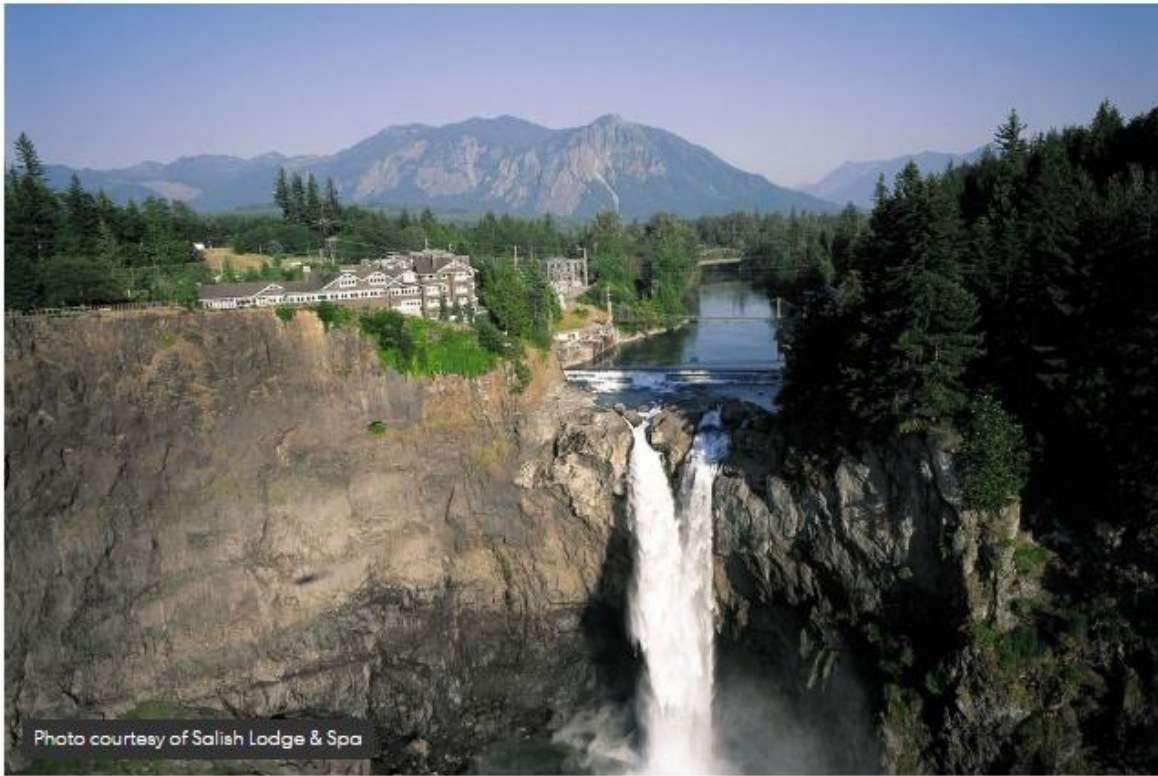
