## The 6 Most Romantic Hotels For Couples

And while some think the hotel doesn't *really* matter, since the room is just a place to store your suitcases and sleep at night, we believe the right hotel can make all the difference during a romantic retreat.

So, we asked travel website [Expedia](#) to help us pinpoint some of the dreamiest hotels in the world. By searching the volume of reviews that mentioned "romance" or described a hotel as "romantic" in combination with overall positive sentiment, the website was able to help us identify a few of the most romantic locales, according to travelers. The hotels that bubbled to the top had at least four stars and a minimum of four out of five reviews from authentic guests. In other words, these hotels are ideal for anyone wanting a dose of romance and great service. Double win for couples, we'd say.

### 3 Salish Lodge & Spa in Snoqualmie, Washington

Originally an eight-room rest stop for travelers journeying over the mountain pass in 1916, the lodge was remodeled in 1988 as the Salish Lodge & Spa, now owned by the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe. Overlooking the Snoqualmie Falls in Washington, the romantic refuge is immersed in nature yet conveniently located just 30 minutes east of Seattle.

Each room is its own personal retreat: You'll find cozy suites with gas fireplaces, pillow menus (you have a choice of six different types of plush), and amazing river views. The lodge boasts a four-hive apiary with 120,000 honeybees, as well as an herb garden—both provide fresh ingredients for its restaurants and spas. To kick off your stay, we suggest the Rekindle Ritual couple's treatment, which includes rosemary mint exfoliation, a shared shower, and heated river rock massage.

If you needed even more proof that this place is *\*seriously\** romantic, the lodge also works with its own romance concierge, Pepper Schwartz. A professor of sociology at the University of Washington and love and relationship expert for the AARP, Schwartz collaborates with Salish to create personalized packages to enhance your stay and refresh your relationship.
