There are many reasons to visit Washington right now, including a major redevelopment to the city of [Seattle's central waterfront](#). Here are five western Washington destinations for your bucket list.

Bainbridge Island: This charming Puget Sound island is a short ferry ride from Seattle and offers parks, trails, restaurants, seven wineries, a brewery and a distillery; <http://visitbainbridge.com>

Chihuly Garden and Glass: Glass artist Dale Chihuly's works in eight galleries plus a glasshouse with a bright suspended sculpture that changes with the day's light. Don't miss: Yoga Under Glass; www.chihulygardenandglass.com

Snoqualmie Falls: This stunning 268-foot waterfall is located east of Seattle on the Snoqualmie River. Take the trail to the lower observation deck then nibble on stone hearth-fired pizzas at [Salish Lodge](#); www.snoqualmiefalls.com

Space Needle: This landmark is in the midst of a major renovation. Upon completion, look for floor-to-ceiling glass at the Observation Deck, and, in the restaurant, the world's first rotating glass floor; www.seewhatsup.space.
